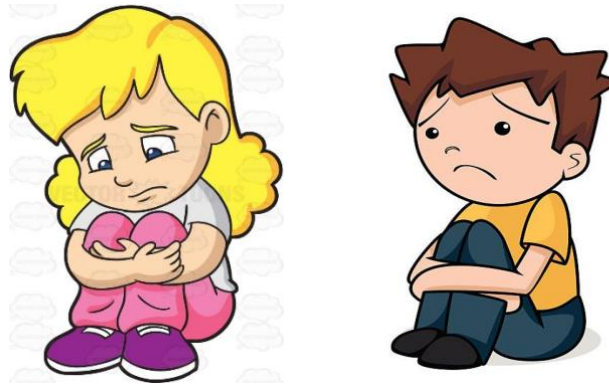

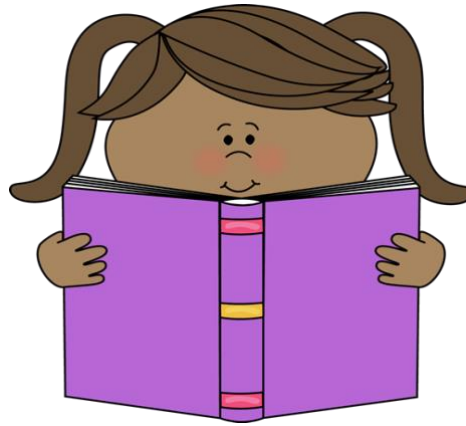
We might feel a bit sad about not going to Dingley's Promise for a while.
